

Bylaws of the BoardChairperson

The chairperson shall preside at all meetings of the Board. He/she shall nominate and appoint all standing and special committees; shall be an ex-officio member of each of the standing and special committees; shall perform all duties imposed by statute; and shall sign all papers and documents as required by law, or as authorized by the action of the Board. The chairperson shall exercise such other powers as properly appertain to his/her office, or which may be conferred on him/her by the Board. The chairperson shall serve as the Board's spokesperson, unless he or she designates another Board member or the Superintendent to act in that capacity.

In the absence of the chairperson and when a quorum has been assembled, the vice-chairperson shall preside.
