

By Laws of the BoardAttorneys

Pursuant to the resolution adopted by the Council of the City of Norwich at a meeting held on November 13, 1984, the Board of Education is authorized to retain outside counsel, when it deems necessary, to represent the Board in employee contract negotiations (including mediation, fact finding, and arbitration) and in the area of personnel hirings, grievances, and terminations.

The Board is expected to utilize the services of the City's Corporation Counsel in all other areas, unless specific authorization to do otherwise is formally given by the City Council, the accordance with the provisions of Chapter XVI, Section 2, of the Norwich City Charter.
