

Bylaws of the BoardQualifications of Members

A person is legally qualified to become a member of the Board of Education who is an elector of the City of Norwich at the time of his/her election. If any such officer shall cease to be a resident of the city, his/her office shall be deemed vacant.

In addition, it would be desirable that members of the Board have a genuine interest in and devotion to children and public education, a willingness to give time and effort to the work, a capacity for understanding people, and the ability to work cooperatively with others.

Employees of the school district are precluded from serving on the Board by reason of state statute which makes it unlawful for a Board member to receive compensation or reward for services to the district. Spouses of employees, however, are not precluded.
